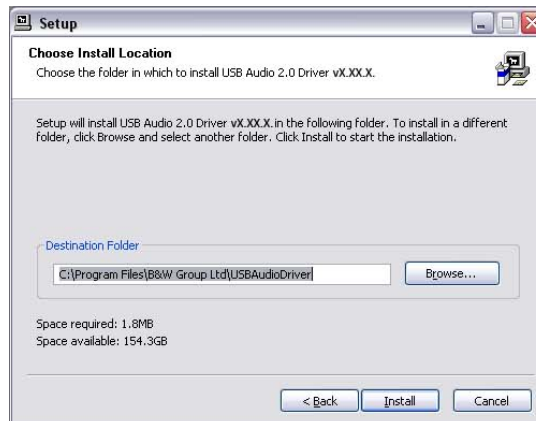


Windows XP

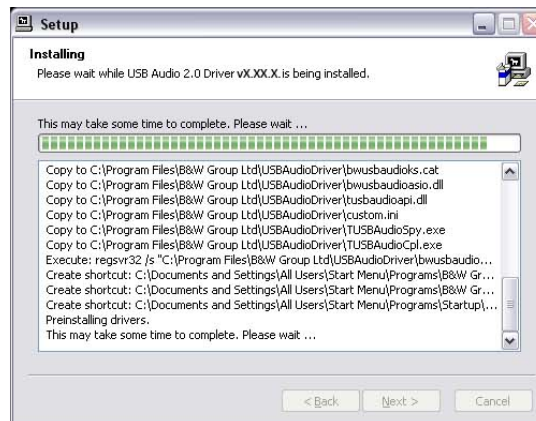
1. Plug the AC cord into the unit and take it out of standby.
2. Connect the unit (rear USB port) to the PC using a USB cable.
3. Double click on the installer (USBAudioDriver.exe) to continue.



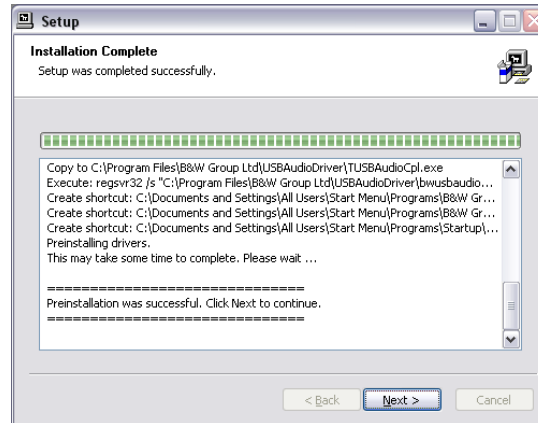
4. Click "Next" to continue with the installation.

6. A progress window will appear.



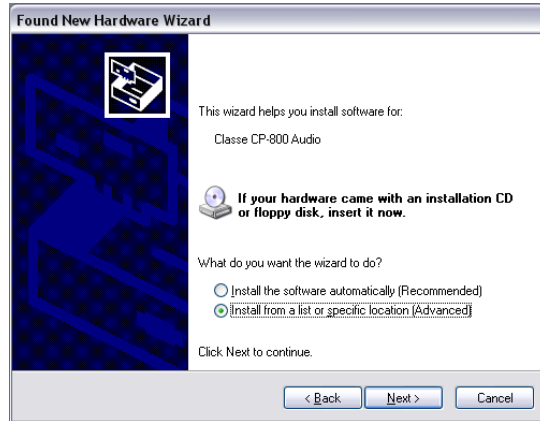
7. Click "Next" once installation is complete.

10. Select "No, not this time" and click "Next" to continue.



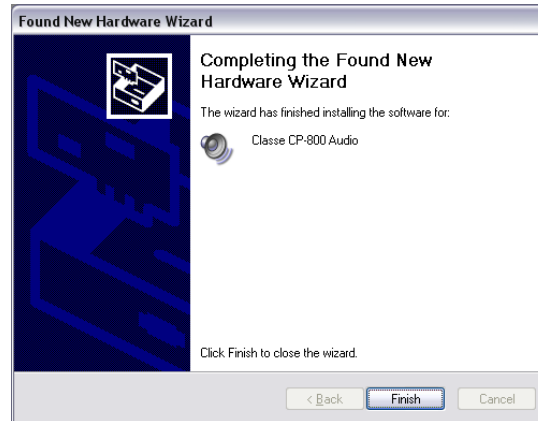
11. Select "Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)" and click "Next" to continue.

13. Click "Next" to continue.



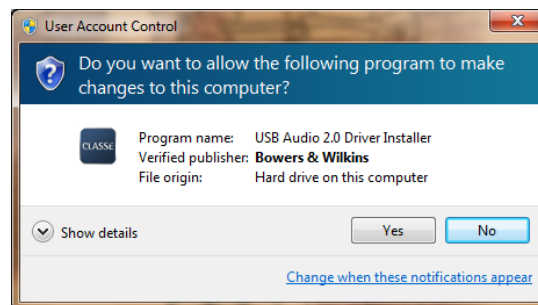
14. A progress window will appear.

Windows 7

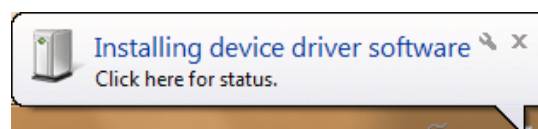
1. Plug the AC cord into the unit and take it out of standby.

3. Double click on the installer (USBAudioDriver.exe) to continue.



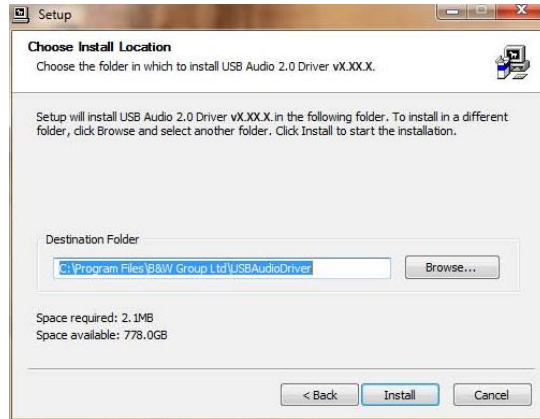
4. Click "Yes" to allow the program to be installed.



5. Click "Next" to continue with the installation.

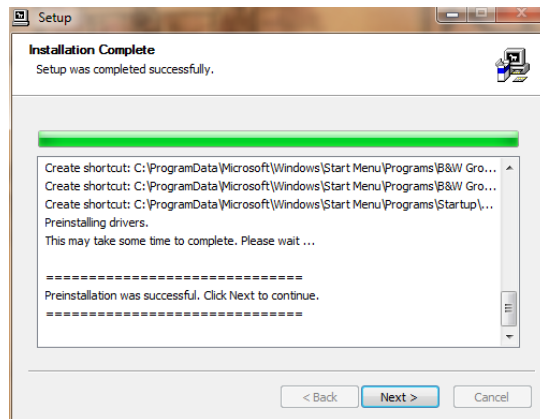


6. A pop-up window will appear showing installation progress.

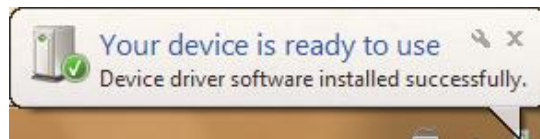


7. Click "Install" to install the drivers in their default location.

9. Click "Next" once installation is complete.

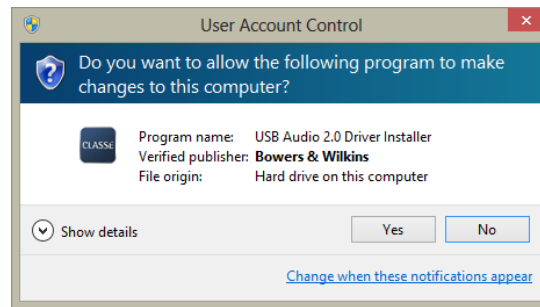


10. A pop-up window will appear showing a successful install.

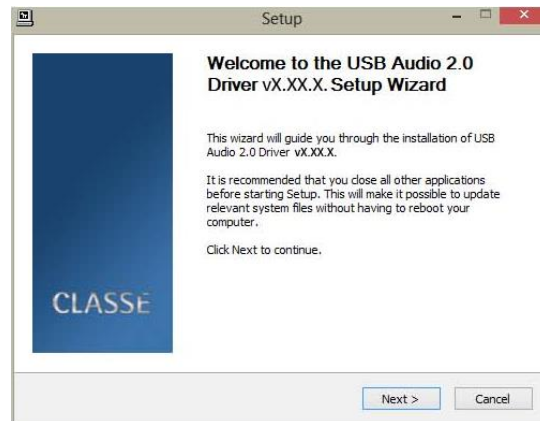
11. The drivers have been successfully installed.

Windows 8

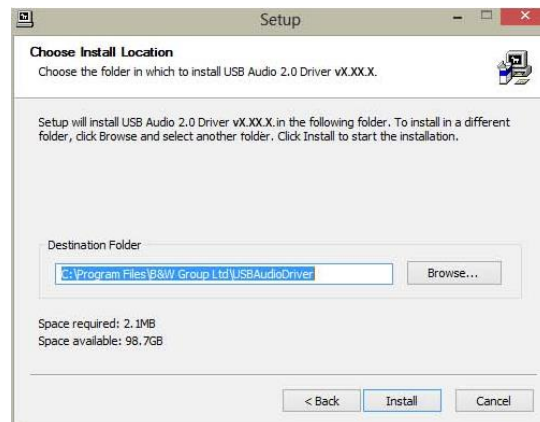
1. Plug the AC cord into the unit and take it out of standby.

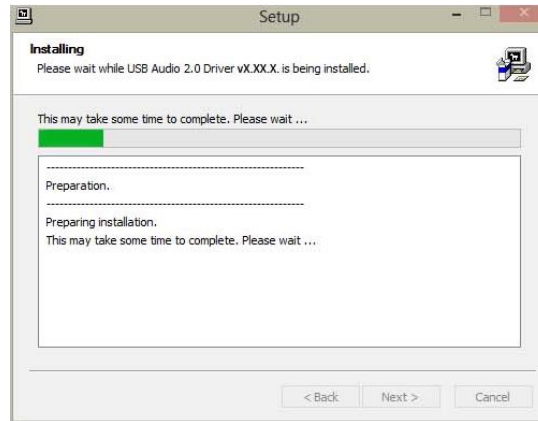
4. Click "Yes" to allow the program to be installed.



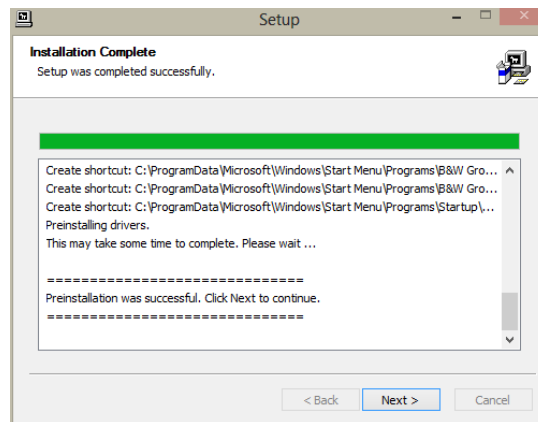
5. Click "Next" to continue with the installation.



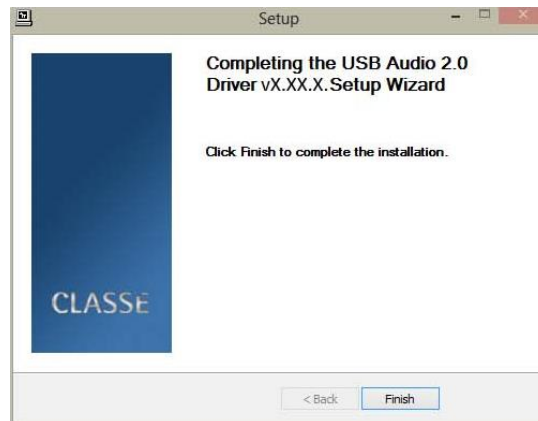
6. Click "Install" to install the drivers in the default location.
